Hello again! As we prepare to begin the 2nd Quarter of the '23-'24 school year, I'd like to give some brief information about my class and what to expect in Art . I'm hoping all students will have the typical Art supplies that were included on their classroom supplies list. I will require the kids to bring those supplies with them to Art. I will let the Kindergarten ~ 2nd grade students store their sketchbooks/pencils in my classroom to help with transporting the supplies. Obviously the supplies like construction paper, tempera paint, chalk, etc. will always be provided. Please check with your child periodically to see if anything needs to be replenished, since the supplies will be used in Art and in the regular classroom.

All students will need the following:


- ~ Scissors (age appropriate)
- ~ Glue Stick
- ~ Elmer's Glue
- ~ Watercolor Paints
- ~ Box/pouch for supplies
- ~ Crayons
- ~ Markers
- ~ Colored Pencils (5-8th)
- ~ Pencils
- ~ Art Sketchbook (no larger than 9x12, please)

Finally, as far as course content is concerned, I will spend the 2nd Quarter continuing our focus on the Elements of Art, while incorporating studies of specific artists. A copy of my grading rubric is below, and I do adhere to it. Almost all students receive an A or B in Art, depending on their understanding of the concept, neatness, creativity, etc. I do not believe in giving everyone an A just because it's an enrichment class, since this will slowly impact the quality of work the kids are capable of creating.
